At Manzes, they still use the same recipes today for the pies and liquor as were used in 1902, the only changes made have been to improve quality and to meet the higher food standards of today. They offer eat in or take-away at any of the three Manzes shops, (there are other Manze shops outside of this family) and can supply small or large quantities of Pies, Eels, Liquor etc. for a 'Cockney' themed evening, party or any occasion you choose. They now offer Online ordering with courier delivery. Manzes also have the capability to supply Pies, Liquor etc to other Pie & Mash shops, or outlets wishing to sell authentic Manzes Pies and Liquor. Open Times : 11am to 2 pm (Mon); 10.30am to 2pm (Tue to Thu); 10am to 2.30pm (Fri); 10am to 3pm (Sat); Closed Sun.
Southwark Brewing Co. Tap Room	46 Druid Street Bermondsey-West London SE1 2EZ Tel No. 020 3302 4190 Web southwarkbrewing.co.uk	An addition to the burgeoning Bermondsey brewing scene, which opened in Autumn 2014. In a railway arch, so hear the trains rumble overhead. Tap room has eight handpumps offering the brewery's regular real ales - London Pale Ale, Bermondsey Best and Gold, plus seasonal and once-off brews. Some beers may be sold on gravity dispense behind the bar too. Open Times : Closed Mon & Wed; 7pm to 10pm (Tue & Thu); 5pm to 10pm (Fri); 11am to 6pm (Sat); 11am to 4pm (Sun). This pub serves 3 regular beers, Southwark Bermondsey Best, Southwark Gold, Southwark London Pale Ale. This tap room serves 5 changing beers, typically including Southwark - varies.
Ubrew Brewery Tap Room	Arches 29-30, 24 Old Jamaica Road Bermondsey (East) London SE16 4AW Web ubrew.cc	Situated in railway arches along what has become known as the Bermondsey Beer Mile, Ubrew is an open brewery where members get to use the facilities to brew their own beer. There are four taps serving key-keg beers from different breweries. There is also an extensive range of bottled beers, much of it bottle conditioned, courtesy of a collaboration with 'Ales by Mail'. There are plans to extend opening hours, sell beers brewed by the members and introduce cask ale in the near future. There is also real cider usually available. Open Times : Closed Mon; 12 Noon to 7pm (Tue & Wed); 12 Noon to 11pm (Thu & Fri); 12 Noon to 7pm (Sat & Sun).

The tap room is open on Saturdays and Sundays and offers up to six of their beers on tap plus a bottled selection to drink on the premises or take away. Open Times : Closed Mon to Thu, 5pm to 9.30pm (Fri); 11am to 5.30pm (Sat); 12 Noon to 5pm (Sun) This tap room serves 1 changing beer, Anspach & Hobday - varies
Bottle Shop (Optional)	128 Druid Street Bermondsey-West London SE1 2HH Tel No. 020 3490 9252	The bottle shop is located in a railway arch within what has come to be known as the Bermondsey Beer Mile. It is predominantly a bottle shop but does open at weekends as a bar with up to 10 key-keg ales available including Danish import To OL in addition to the wide range of bottled beers. Open Times : Closed Mon to Thu, 5pm to 9.30pm (Fri); 10am to 7pm (Sat); 12.30pm to 5.30pm (Sun)
Brew By Numbers Brewery Tap Room (Optional)	79 Enid Street Bermondsey (East) London SE16 3RA Tel No. 020 7237 9794 Web brewbynumbers.com	Craft brewery situated in a railway arch and forming one of the string of breweries that has become known as the Bermondsey Beer Mile. Each of the wide range of changing brews bears a 2-part reference number - the first part denoting one of 14 beer styles and the second part the recipe variant. Has a tap room (open on Saturdays only) with 6 taps and a single ale in cask. There is a small indoor area plus outdoor bench seating. Open Times : Closed Mon to Fri, 10am to 5pm (Sat); Closed Sun This tap room serves 1 changing beer, Brew By Numbers - varies

eEbria Taproom	15 Almond Road Bermondsey (East) London SE16 3LR Tel No. Web eebria.com/page/view/taproom	Open on Saturdays only and not strictly a taproom as they don't brew any beer, but there are a number of KeyKeg draught beers from microbreweries and also a selection of cans and bottles available. It is situated in a railway arch on what is known as the Bermondsey Beer Mile, close to the Partizan Brewery. Entertainments on site include a free air hockey table and shuffleboard. Regular tap takeovers. Open Times : Closed Mon to Fri, 11am to 5pm (Sat); Closed Sun

They have been inspired by its founder's experimental, home brew roots. Andy hails from the artistic town of Leeds, which is perhaps the reason why Partizan's beer bottles have such a colourful, attractive aesthetic. Alongside his business partner (also named Andy) they brew loads of delicious beer every week - all from a little factory down a London lane. Fourpure Brewery Tap Room	22 Bermondsey Trading Estate, Rotherhithe New Road Bermondsey (East) London SE16 3LL Tel No. Web fourpure.com	Craft beer producer situated at the eastern end of a string of breweries that has become known as the Bermondsey Beer Mile. Has a spacious tap room (open on Saturdays only) surrounded by the brewing kit, with up to 13 taps available. The brewery produces 6 regular beers (Pils, Session IPA, IPA, Pale Ale, Amber Ale, Oatmeal Stout) plus a varying range of special brews. Bar snacks and table tennis also available. Open Times : Closed Mon to Fri, 11am to 5pm (Sat); Closed Sun
